He alone can turn the wrong things into right.

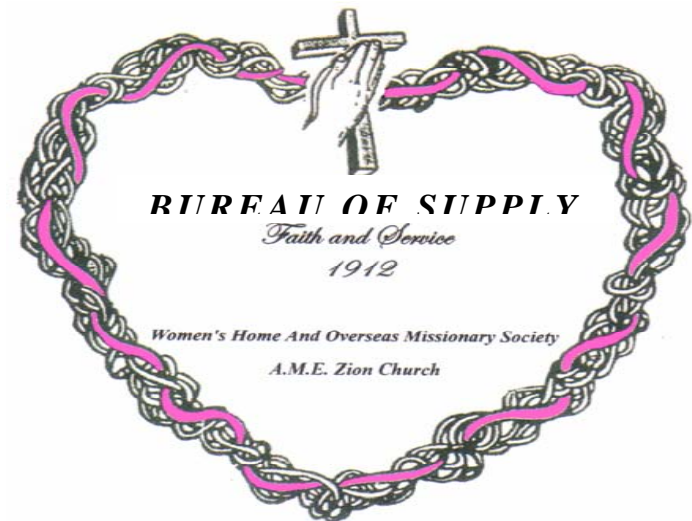
For He's given you His promise
